Checklist for Church Leaders

1. Clear Vision & Mission
\square Our church has a written vision and mission statement.
\square Every ministry aligns with this vision.

2. Defined Leadership Structure
\square We have a clear organizational chart or leadership framework.
\square Ministry leaders know their responsibilities.
\square Roles are filled based on gifting, not just availability.
3. Communication Systems
\square There is a regular flow of internal communication among leaders.
\square Church announcements are shared across consistent platforms.
\square We use tools (email, group chat, software) to communicate efficiently.
4. Ministry Alignment & Collaboration
\square Ministries are not working in silos.
\square There is a regular planning rhythm between departments.
$\hfill\square$ We evaluate ministries for effectiveness and alignment.
5. Volunteer Development
\square Volunteers receive orientation and training.
\square We have a system to recruit, place, and appreciate volunteers.
$\hfill\square$ Volunteers are not overburdened and have clear expectations.
6. Worship & Event Planning
☐ Our worship services are thoughtfully planned in advance.
☐ We use a worship flow document or agenda.
\square We evaluate and review services for effectiveness.
7. Administrative & Financial Systems
\square We have a church manual or SOPs (standard operating procedure) in place.
☐ Budgets are set and tracked responsibly.
\square Our financial reports are reviewed and communicated transparently.
